- 3. Y N Will the project involve construction or alteration of any sewage collection or treatment facility? For facilities discharging to surface waters or ground waters, Contact: EGLE Kalamazoo District. Water Bureau: 269-567-3500.
- 4. Y N Will the project or facility store or use chemicals, petroleum products, or salt? Depending on the type of substance, secondary containment, and a pollution Incident Prevention Plan (PIPP) may be required.
